Camp Tesomas Medication Policies

POLICIES

- Units are encouraged to administer medication to the youth at camp under their supervision.
- Wisconsin DPI Medication Administration Training is required under Wisconsin State Law.
- Medication should be administered by a registered adult over the age of 21.
- The responsible adult administering medication needs complete the DPI Medication Administration Training. A certificate of training will need to be emailed to camp@samoset.org. Meaning, at least one adult from every unit should complete the training.
- Parents or court-appointed guardians administering medication to their own child are not required
 to take this training. Parents/guardians administering medication to their own children & adults
 administering their own medication should take reasonable effort to secure all medications.
- Medication must be secured in a vehicle or other secure way.
- All units administering medications are required to fill out a medication log book, and return to camp health staff upon check out.
